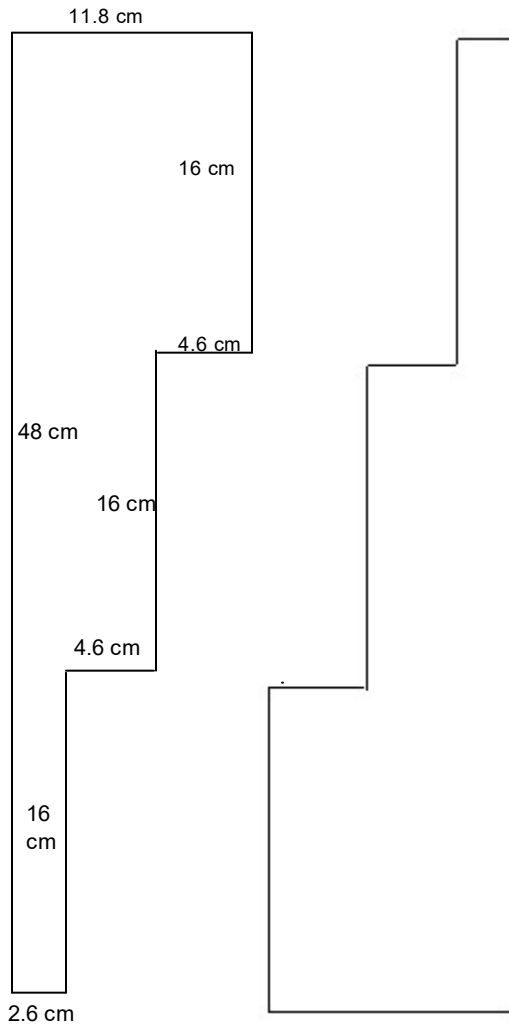


Variation on the Kent Bat Box



Wishing to make a bat box I ran a Google search and found the design made available by the Kent Bat Group at <http://www.kentbatgroup.org.uk/kent-bat-box.pdf>



The variation came about because the only boards I could source were about the right thickness (actually slightly thicker than the original plan) but only about 15 cm wide.

To compensate I redesigned the box to have solid sides rather than spacer pieces to separate the front, mid and back boards.

The two sides, with the dimensions shown on the left, can be cut from the width of the board using a vibrating multi tool.



The front, mid and back boards are each 15 cm wide (the full width of the board) and 16, 32 and 48 cm deep respectively. The roof is 24 cm wide by 15 cm deep.

The pieces are screwed together and the box is fixed to the wall using corner braces as shown in the photos (but only because that was the convenient way to do it).

The image on the left doesn't show the full depth because our shed roof got in the way.
